Actually this college caters to the needs of rural graduates and post graduates to complete the professional training so that they can be awarded B.Ed and later M.Ed., Degree to become full fledged teachers in the High and Higher Secondary Schools. Vidyaa Vikas College of Education is run by Vidyaa Vikas Educational and Charitable Trust which also runs an excellent Engineering College, High and Higher Secondary Schools, attached both to the State Board of Education and Matric Board. Because of these quality conscious Educational Institutions, Varahoorampatti village is fast becoming a well developed and posh suburban area adjacent to the town Tiruchengode. The well Administered Vidyaa Vikas High and Higher secondary schools also serve as typical model schools for this college of Education where the B.Ed., Trainees take their teaching practice.
